Junior League Plans Fourth Annual Fish For All Tournament

It's spring and that means it's time for the Junior League of Greater Fort Lauderdale's Fourth Annual Fish For All. This year's Offshore Fishing Tournament and Family Fish Fry will take place on April 27 at the Lauderdale Yacht Club. Participating anglers can win more than \$4,000 in cash and prizes if they bring in the biggest catch.

The Offshore Fishing Tournament begins at 7 a.m. with a Home Port start out of Port Everglades. Participants will have until 3 p.m. to catch the biggest fish they can. The weigh-in will start at 2 p.m. at the Lauderdale Yacht Club and prizes will be given at the awards ceremony at 6 p.m. Cost to participate is \$400 for one boat with four anglers and includes 4 tickets to the Family Fish Fry.

The Family Fish Fry will take place at the Lauderdale Yacht Club from 3:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. on Sunday afternoon. Tickets are \$35 in advance and \$40 at the door. Children under 12 are \$15. There will be lots of food, Gosling's Rum drink specials, games for kids, live entertainment by Catfish, and a silent auction.

Event sponsors include RBC Centura Bank, Fastboats.com, Gosling's Rum, Stiles Corporation, the Academy of Design, Maroone and Blue Water chairs.

The Junior League of Greater Fort Lauderdale uses the proceeds from the Fish For All and other annual fundraisers to support current projects, including the signature Junior League Play Station at Holiday Park, Ronald McDonald House, a new program to benefit teenagers who have aged out of the foster care system, and numerous Leagues on Loan projects throughout the year.
