The weigh-in will go from 2:00 p.m. until 5:00 p.m. at the Lauderdale Yacht Club and prizes will be awarded during the awards ceremony at 6:00 p.m. Cost to participate is \$400 for one boat with four anglers and includes 4 tickets to the Family Fish Fry.

The **Family Fish Fry** will take place at the Lauderdale Yacht Club from 3:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. on Sunday afternoon. Tickets are \$35 in advance and \$40 at the door. Children under 12 are \$15. There will be lots of great food, Gosling's Rum drink specials, games for the kids, live entertainment by Catfish, and a silent auction.
